


Encouraging people to listen.



1 Start with paper colour side down.




2 Fold in half and crease well



3 Open, turn 90° and fold in half again.
Crease well.




For each Scottie you need


1 6" x 6" origami square in black ([available on Amazon](#))
Tartan ribbon - not essential
Silver, gold or white gel pen.

Scotties make people smile. This one is designed to be a name card for the dinner table. You write the names of your guests on the front and then write a question they can ask the person sitting next to them inside. A 'sneaky' way to refresh positive conversations which encourage people to listen to the stories of those sitting next to them and learn something about them they didn't know before.


5 Crease diagonally once




9 Refold left point along
crease B. Fold point
back so the it protrudes
slightly past the edge.
This is the tail!




6 Fold left point to centre
and repeat for right
point.




10 Refold along centre
crease line




7 Fold right point to half

8 Refold along crease A




11 Fold top upwards and

point D




Turn over and repeat




Fold down along the
